Living Signposts



Have you ever given any thought to how important signposts are in our world? Can you imagine the problems that we would have getting from one place to another without them? What about the problem that we would have in directing someone to a particular place?

Christians should also act as living signpost:

- In our efforts to win the lost to Christ it is important that we give direction. To direct them to a God who loves them and a Savior who died for them
- In our efforts to encourage one another to stay on track with our daily walk with Christ we need to give the proper direction through our own actions

All of us are called to spend our lives 'signposting' those around us to Jesus.

The Apostle Peter in his first letter tells us:

- Always be ready to give a reason for our hope in Jesus (1Peter 3:15)
- Live such good lives among non-believers that they will glorify God (1Peter 2:12)
- And he shows the foundation of our faith being built on the Gospel of Jesus Christ chosen before creation to bring us life (1Peter 1:19-20)

As Christians in our workplaces, schools and communities we need to build our lives around these three things - a certain knowledge of the truth of the Gospel, a lifestyle in our workplace, schools and communities that alone could cause others to glorify God, and the words - ready to speak whenever anyone asks us to explain why we are as we are.
